The Wyoming State Emergency Response Commission (SERC) intends to adopt new rules pursuant to WYO. STAT. ANN. § 35-9-153(h) AND (j), 2008 WYO. SESS. LAWS 227. The purpose of adopting the new rules are as follows: In the 2008 budget session, the legislature directed the SERC to promulgate rules for the testing and remediation of clandestine laboratories including standards for the protection of responding personnel, standards for declaring a site uninhabitable, standards for determining the extent of contamination, standards for declaring a site remediated, and due process standards for the protection of real property owners. WYO. STAT. ANN. § 35-9-153(h) and (j).

The SERC proposes to adopt Chapter 2, Clandestine Lab Testing and Remediation, in response to the new legislation.
